We are once again opening opportunities for students and student-athletes to be a Crossover Coaches in leading drills, learning about the culture, and connecting with local students in Chennai, India. There are also other ways you will be expected to be involved - including assisting with logistics, documenting the program via photography and video, collecting data, or helping the program in other ways based on student interest and program needs. For all students, there will be a **writing and reflection program** to take advantage of this out-of-context experience. We will keep blogs, journals, and tweet before, during and after we are in Chennai. In no way is this a vacation or a “show-up” service-tourism trip.

Furthermore, we will discuss ways in which this experience can supplement the work you do at your school. Cost for American students to participate in the program is \$3500. That includes **roundtrip airfare** from Boston to Chennai and **all of the expenses** (food, lodging, transportation, government entrance fees) in India. There is financial aid available and will be awarded through the decision of our board. You will need to secure a passport and visa.

The cost for local Chennai students to attend the Hoops Creating Hope program is free. High school teachers as well as Crossover’s volunteers will serve as chaperones.
